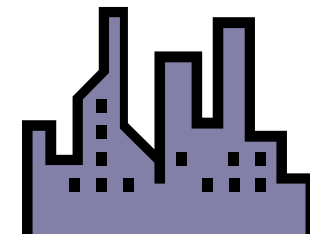

The letter (**one page or less, single-spaced**) should explain why your nominee(s) is/are worthy of the team's consideration. Supporting documentation can be attached, but nomination may be no more than one page in length. ***Anything past one page will not be reviewed**

You may self-nominate.

Nominate for the Following:

Emerging Leader Award:

This award focuses on the first year or sophomore student leader (student with less than 60 credits) who has shown the most promise of leadership. The promise could be displayed through leadership roles or active participation in the student organizations, academia, or service.

Organization Program of the Year:

This award will be presented to a group or groups who have provided the most outstanding program to the West Chester University campus, with consideration to those who have focused on philanthropic, consciousness-raising, entertaining, social, cultural diversity, or educational topics. Programs held on or off campus will be judged on the following (as it applies): originality, creativity, popularity, values to the community, and degree to which the program has fulfilled the intended purpose. (*Eligible program nominations will have occurred between March 7, 2007 and March 6, 2008*)

Organization Advisor of the Year:

This award will be given to an advisor who has served a West Chester University group above and beyond his/her respective job description. This individual may be new to the position or may have been working with the group for several years. (*only nominations from students will be considered*)

WCU Leader Award:

This award will be presented to a West Chester University student who has held a variety of leadership positions and have demonstrated outstanding leadership qualities. Please include information on how this nominated individual has impacted the campus community.

Community Service Leadership Award:

This award will be given to a group/organization that has created, participated in, and coordinated a wide variety of community service projects. ****Please attach a listing of the projects to the one page summary.**** (*Eligible service nominations will have occurred between March 7, 2007 and March 6, 2008*)

The People's Choice Award:

This award will be presented to an individual at WCU (student or employee) who has a genuine concern for others, is committed to serve and has gone above and beyond the call of duty for the betterment of the campus community. Please include in your letter how this person has impacted you and/or the student body.

Senior Leader Award:

This award focuses upon the senior leader (student with 90 or more credits) who has shown the most capable leadership ability throughout his/her years at WCU. The individual's leadership ability may have been displayed through excellence in student organizations, academia, or service.

Organization of the Year Award:

This award will be presented to a club or organization that has demonstrated outstanding leadership qualities. Such qualities may have been displayed through involvement in student activities, leadership development, organizational programming, and/or service. Please include information pertaining to how this particular organization has impacted the campus community.

Most Improved Student Organization Award

This award will be presented to a club or organization that has made significant strides towards achieving their goals and mission. Please include the role of leadership in this change and how the organization has transformed itself since last March, 2007.
